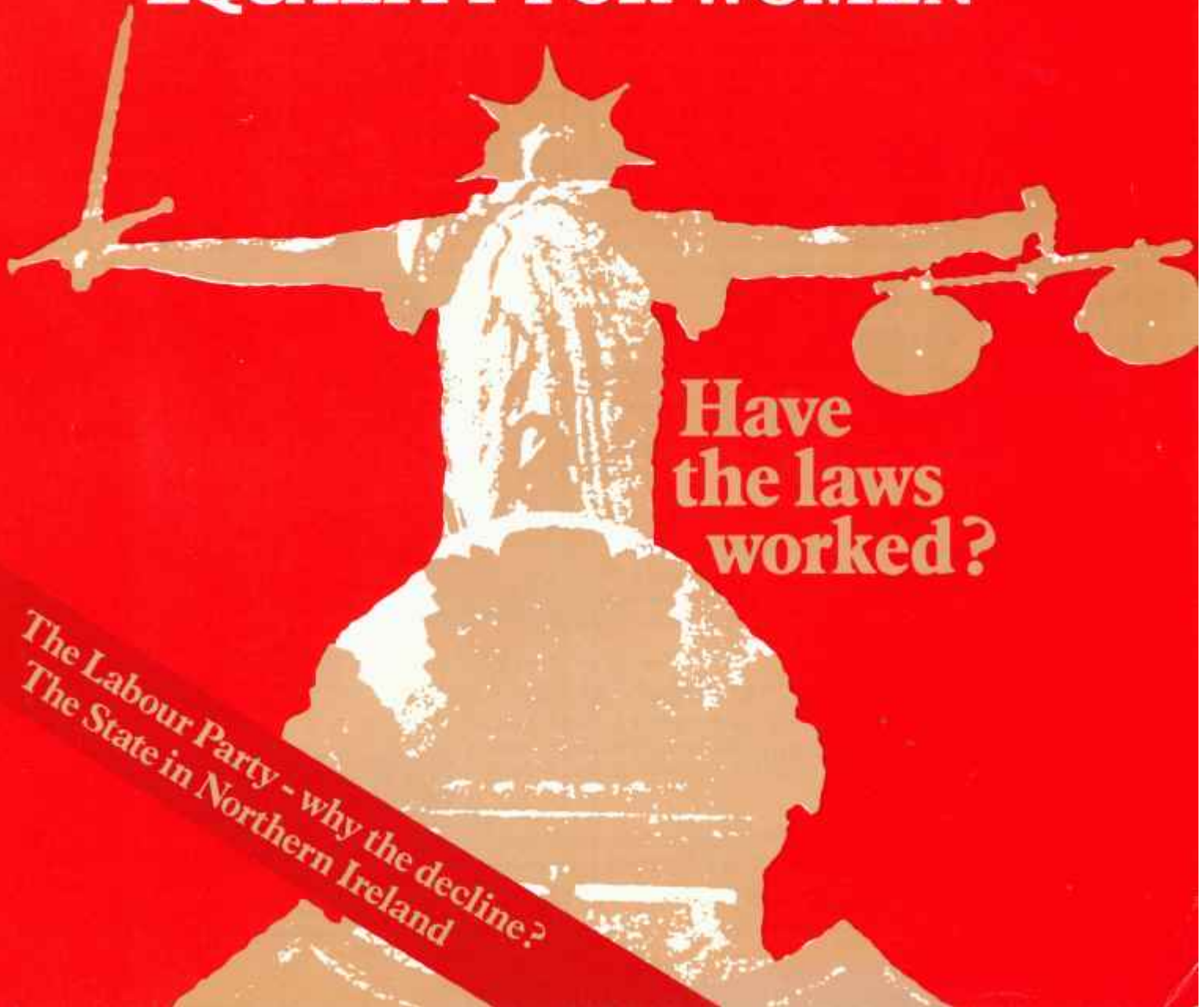

A major theoretical study, based on a close political reading of the *Prison Notebooks*, which shows why and how Gramsci's acute understanding of the advanced capitalist state led him to rethink and revitalize the problem of revolution in Western Europe.

Containing an analysis of Proudhon's writings on art, an essay on 'The Marxist Theory of Art' and a critical assessment of Picasso, the three essays in this volume form a valuable contribution to the field of Marxist aesthetics. The central essay demonstrates that the emphasis in modern Marxism on the relative autonomy of the superstructure — particularly the cultural sphere — was also stressed by Raphael as far back as the early thirties.

Capitalism, Conflict and Inflation

The essays in this volume deal with classical themes of political economy, including imperialism, capitalist development, inflation; it also contains more specialized pieces, on Marx's theory of wages, and on the political economy of Rosa Luxemburg. All are united by the author's unorthodox insistence on the importance of power and conflict in capitalist economies.

The General Strike of 1842

The first full-length study of what was probably the first strike anywhere in the world that can truly be called general. Breaking out at the height of the Chartist campaign for basic democratic rights, the strike almost immediately became an all-out struggle for universal suffrage, and quickly spread north and south from its origins in the cotton mills of Lancashire to become the biggest single exercise of working-class power in nineteenth-century Britain.
