

Vol 13, 1854 - 1855

This volume covers the period of the Crimean War and contains Engels' acute analysis of its military strategy and tactics (including his comments on the 'Charge of the Light Brigade'), as well as his and Marx's examination of the war's political implications — primarily its effect on the European revolutionary movement and on the prospects for the revolution in Russia itself. The volume also covers the period of the 1854 Revolution against the Spanish monarchy, which began as a military uprising and developed into a popular insurrection. In analysing these events, Marx set them in their national historical context and provided a concise outline history of post-Napoleonic Spain.
