This book provides an overview of the ambivalent relationship between Marxism and philosophy. Starting with Marx himself and the influence of Hegelianism, the author surveys the various schools of Marxist philosophy, from the time of Engels and the second International, through the revolutionary Hegelianism of the 1920s, the Frankfurt School, and finally Althusser. He examines the differences and similarities between Marxism and post-Fregean philosophy as practised in the English-speaking world. The author concludes with a discussion of the contemporary debates provoked by realist accounts of knowledge and of meaning, and their relevance to historical materialism and in particular to theories of ideology. £9.50
