## WARNER BROTHERS IN THE 1930S

**A New Deal in Entertainment:  
Warner Brothers in the 1930s**  
By Nick Roddick

Warner Brothers, more than any other studio, reflected the immense changes in American society during the 1930s. It was the period of the Depression, Roosevelt's New Deal, economic recovery and political isolationism. It was also the heyday of the Hollywood studio.

This book examines the Warners' studio and films it produced between the 1929 Wall Street Crash and America's entry into the war in 1941. Gangster films like *Angels with Dirty Faces* portrayed not just the criminals but the social background to crime. Biographies like *The Story of Louis Pasteur* stressed the importance of individual enterprise and films such as *The Maltese Falcon* echoed the darker mood at the end of the decade. Nick Roddick provides a uniquely detailed account of a film studio which was both typical and extraordinary. £6.95

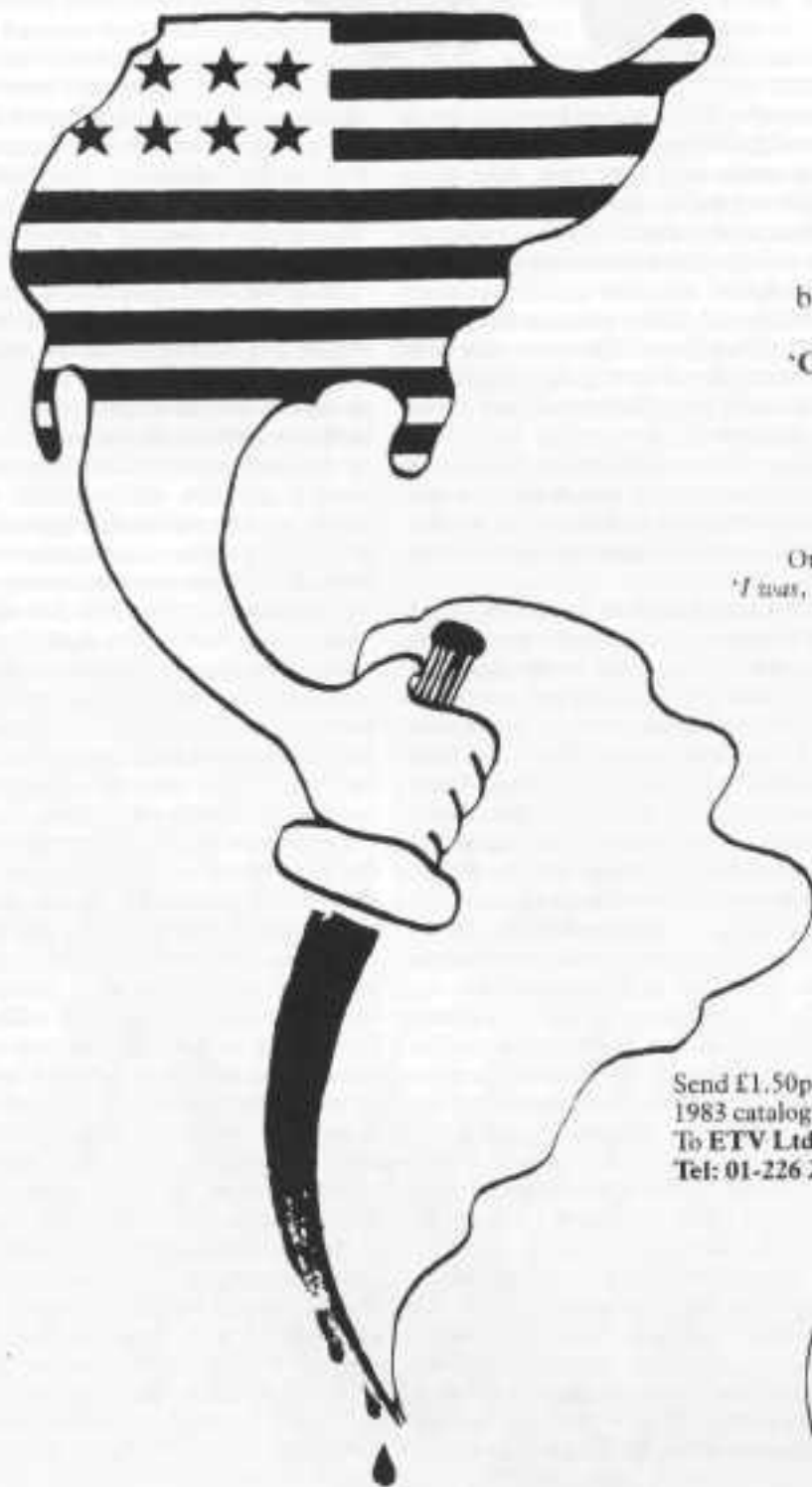
