As author of an award-winning biography of Orwell, Bernard Crick is particularly well-qualified to assess Orwell's intentions, the context in which the novel was written and its contemporary impact.

His introduction to this fully-annotated edition shows the book to be a specifically Swittian satire, related closely to concerns of the time, but only superficially to either anti-Utopian or science-fiction writings. He demonstrates its ambitious complexity, identifying seven major objects of satire. On two questions — whether power can be total, and whether all truth can be controlled — Crick believes that Orwell never finally made up his mind.

WE ARE COMMITTED TO THE DEFENCE & EXTENSION OF CIVIL LIBERTIES IN THE UNITED KINGDOM & TO THE RIGHTS & FREEDOMS RECOGNISED BY INTERNATIONAL LAW. IN PARTICULAR, WE ARE PLEDGED TO ENSURE & SAFEGUARD THESE ESSENTIAL RIGHTS:-

- 1 to live in freedom and safe from personal harm.
- 2 to protection from ill-treatment or punishment that is inhuman or degrading.
- 3 to equality before the law and to freedom from discrimination on such grounds as disability, political or other opinion, race, religion, sex, or sexual orientation.
- 4 to protection from arbitrary arrest and unnecessary detention, the right to a fair, speedy and public trial, to be presumed innocent until proved guilty, and to legal advice and representation.
- 5 to a fair hearing before any authority exercising power over the individual.
- 6 to freedom of thought, conscience and belief.
- 7 to freedom of speech and publication.
- 8 to freedom of peaceful assembly and association.
- 9 to move freely within one's country of residence and to leave and enter it without hindrance.
- 10 to privacy and the right of access to official information.

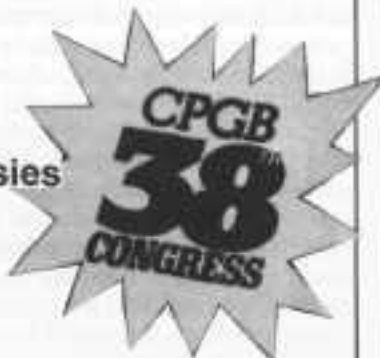

# Carry Greenham Home

A FILM BY BEEBAN KIDRON and AMANDA RICHARDSON

The actions of the women's peace camp at Greenham Common have brought home the issues surrounding cruise missiles to a huge audience: local people, politicians, the general public, the media and the peace movement internationally.

*Carry Greenham Home* was filmed over seven months with the support of the Greenham women. It covers the best known actions: the big blockades, the 'embrace the base' action, the sleeping on the site, the Easter actions and an eviction of the camp by Newbury Council. It also covers some of the more private actions that are part of the continuing protest around the base as well as showing the daily life of the camp and the difficulties of seeking and establishing new values and ways of living. It exposes the media's relationship to a provocative subject.

*Carry Greenham Home* is not so much about the 'pros and cons' of cruise missiles, it is about the power and strength of opposition, the implications of non-violent protest and of living non-hierarchically in an all women's community. It shows women coming to Greenham with a single purpose and carrying home a broader and more far-reaching view of the struggle for peace.
