LONDON AGAINST RACISM

1984 sees the start of a major drive by the GLC to make people aware of the damaging and divisive effects of racism in London.

The facts of racial disadvantage ought to be well known, but too often people choose to ignore or condone them – especially the way larger organisations perpetuate racism in their structures and practices.

To be effective, the London Against Racism campaign needs your support.

 - 3** Create conditions, at home, at work and in the community that make it impossible for racism to operate.
 - 4** Join with all ordinary people in London to fight the disadvantages common to them all.
 - 5** Examine, criticise, challenge and change the structures that perpetuate racism in organisations.
- Don't sit back and leave it to others. *Your* contribution is vital.

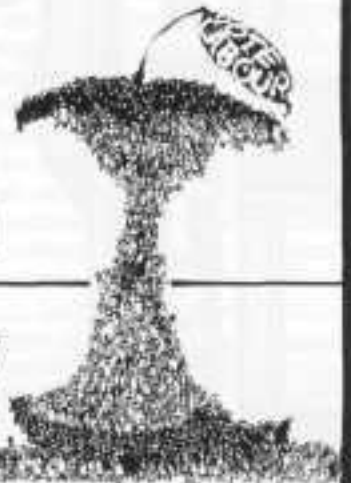
