# Policing London

**The Police and Criminal Evidence Act  
came into full operation on January 1st 1986.  
Find out what it will mean.**

The Police Bill of 1984 is now the Police and Criminal Evidence Act. As of 1st January this year, it is fully operational. It marks a new level of police powers. It allows the police to decide what arrestable offences are 'serious' and to use 'reasonable' force in the exercise of their new powers.

The police now have extended powers to stop and search you. And they have new powers to establish road blocks and search premises. They can arrest you for any offence if, for example, you fail to give your name and address. The police can also detain you at a police station without contact with the outside world for up to 36 hours. They can strip-search you and submit you to an intimate body search.

Not enough is known about these new powers or the way in which they will be used. That is why the GLC has prepared information material describing them. These

are available FREE and you are invited to send for them today. They contain information which is of vital importance to all Londoners.
