House of Lords

The unelected and landowning Conservative majority in the House of Lords has consistently rejected any legislation passed by the elected House of Commons to abolish hare coursing and hunting with dogs.

Their argument is that the House of Commons must have a 'mandate' to enact such legislation.

In 1976, the Labour Government Bill to abolish hare coursing received a majority of 117 in the House of Commons. Despite that majority and massive public support, their Lordships threw out the Bill because it was not in the Labour Party's 1974 Election Manifesto.

Because of this, MPs will not waste a Private Members' Bill on this issue. That is why a Labour Party Manifesto commitment is an absolutely essential requirement for wildlife protection.

It is not an attempt to 'bind' the PLP - it is simply a constitutional and procedural matter.

Please use your influence to ensure that the next Labour Party Manifesto contains just one line to give wild animals the same basic protection from cruelty as domestic animals received 75 years ago.

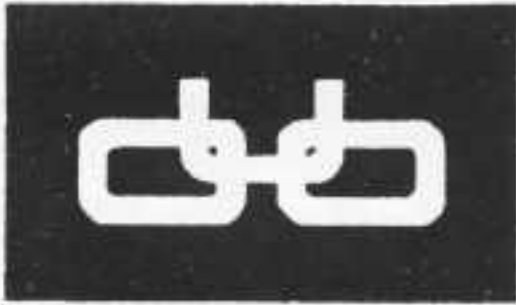

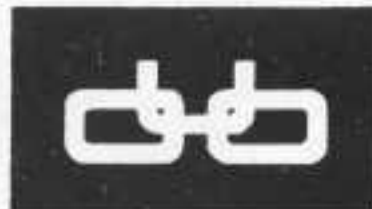

WIPE APARTHEID OFF THE MAP

Each Friday the Scottish Anti-Apartheid Movement pickets the South African Consulate in Glasgow. On Saturday 11 October it is organising an all Scottish Demonstration there.

To add to their impact the Communist Party is staging marches, runs and cycle rides in relays to converge on Glasgow on Friday 17 October. Banners and flags of the ANC will be passed from stage to stage along the routes and on to the final picket in Glasgow.

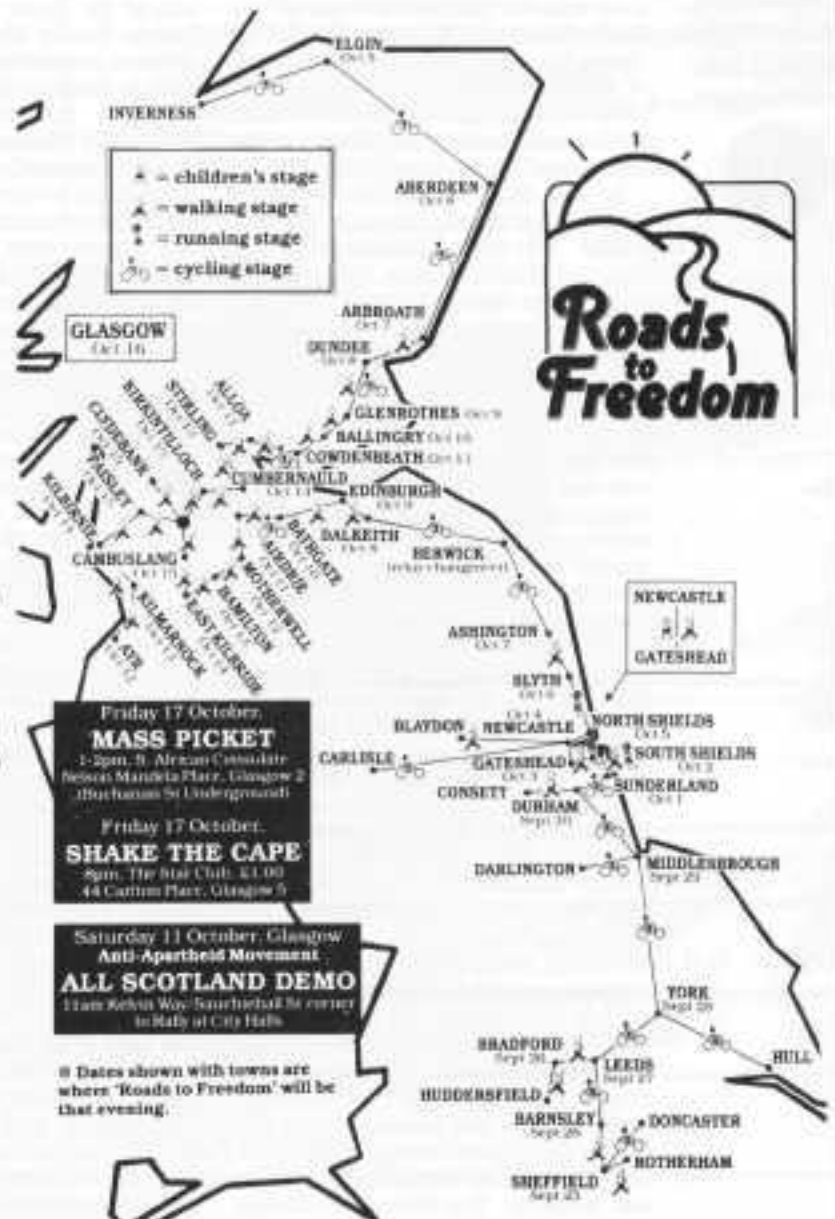

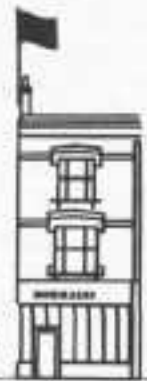
