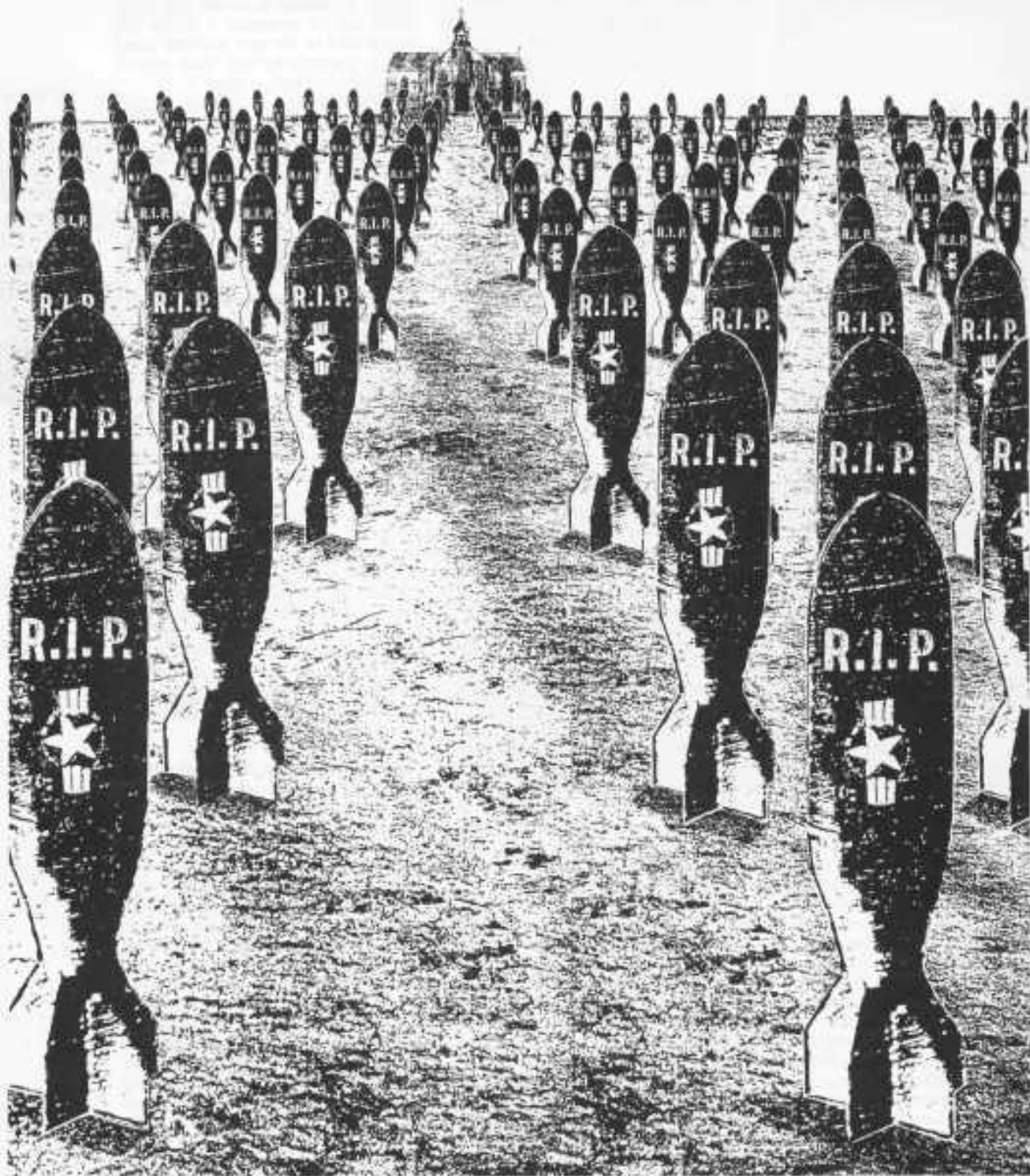

Take-away kebabs and too much oil is how many view Greek food. The cuisine has suffered from being transplanted to Britain but it is possible to find the real thing (or something like it) and the search will not go unrewarded.

The pleasure of Mediterranean meals is the leisure with which they are enjoyed and Greek restaurants are not a place to skip hors-d'oeuvres. Meze is a wide range of small portions, suitable for vegetarians: chick pea (houmous) and roe (taramosalata) dips or stuffed vine leaves. Lamb is a staple of Greek food but chicken and spicy sausages are found too and all can be washed down with quantities of retzina or ouzo. Puddings are on the sticky side, variations on the theme of nuts, honey and layers of flaky pastry dough.

A range of inexpensive (under £10 a head) restaurants around the country are listed below.
The Hellenik 86 St John Street,

EC1. Squid is served here in a special sauce as well as the usual fried version and the kleftiko (a litmus test of the good Greek restaurant) is tender and well seasoned. **Nontas** 16 Camden High Street, NW1. A small family-run place with a quiet atmosphere. **Rhodos Kebab House** 59 St Giles High Street, WC2. Good selection of meze, and their late hours accommodate the theatrical types that come here. **The Troy** 65 Red Lion Street, WC1. Several unusual dishes here and usually empty for an inexpensive lunch. **Anastasia** 189 Penarth Road, Cardiff. Recommended by one of our readers who says the owners are very friendly. **Chalice**, Cannon Street, Bury St Edmunds. A vegetarian restaurant that serves a few carefully prepared Greek recipes.

Kebab House Hardman Street, Liverpool 7. **Eureka** Myrtle Parade, Liverpool 7. Both popular, Eureka is especially good at snacks.

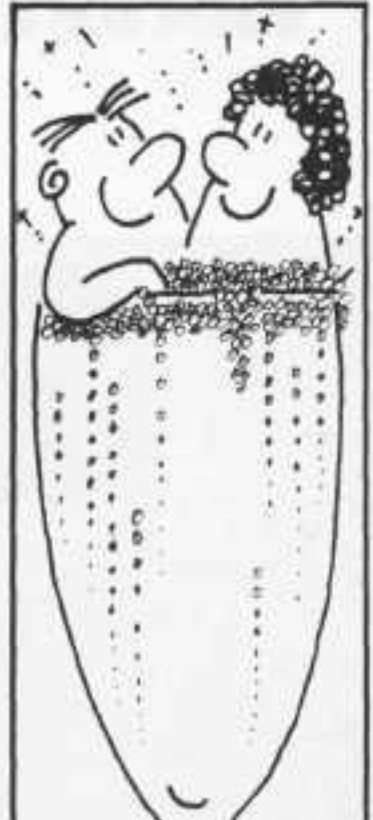
