In terms of total income from employment, men receive almost two and a half times as much as women, although the labour force is almost evenly composed of men and women.

Why do women lose out and by how much?

To answer these questions, the GMB surveyed 650 agreements covering 100,000 of its members. The findings and a 13 point bargaining agenda to eliminate sex bias are set out in a 24 page booklet called: "Winning a Fair Deal for Women."
