'Without the ICA and its willingness to take risks, the arts in London would grow notably dimmer, greyer and meaner. While recognising the need to put bums on seats, the ICA knows that there is no argument between genres or media, only a search for quality in and perhaps even between them. I've sat in on some of its naffest mistakes in this search, as well as successes that I'll remember for decades. The day it closes will be the day I get on a plane for the Mediterranean and don't comeback.'
