We declare our anger at the growing numbers of young people who are homeless.

Many have no choice but to live independently, yet they cannot afford even basic accommodation.

We demand that young people are given the means to help them find somewhere to live which meets their needs.

We are asking that young people are given a break.

All young people living independently who are not on YTS or in employment should receive Income Support and Housing Benefit at the same rate as over 25 year olds.

Grants should be made available to enable young people to move into a place they can call home.

Income support should be paid in advance.

The homelessness laws should be made to cover young people.

More homes at affordable rents should be provided by socially responsible landlords for young people.
