## VOLGA CRUISE & RUSSIAN COURSE

Ship shared with Soviet passengers plus optional daily Russian language course for beginners and advanced students, in small groups with specialist teachers. Last-minute applications are possible.

### Soviet Union

Seven to 13 days in Moscow, Leningrad and other cities with some seven day tours to Moscow or Leningrad only.

### Omsk and Moscow Marathons

Range of tours, all departing August 1, to include Siberian (Aug 6) and Moscow (Aug 11) marathons, plus travel in Siberia and Central Asia.

### Study Programmes

#### Soviet History, Politics and Economics

#### Russian Language Courses

One month courses in Moscow and Leningrad, plus several other centres including Kalinin and Novosibirsk between July and the end of September. Three month courses at Kiev (summer term) and Yaroslavl on the Volga (autumn), many also commence in Moscow.
