# Development Work Overseas

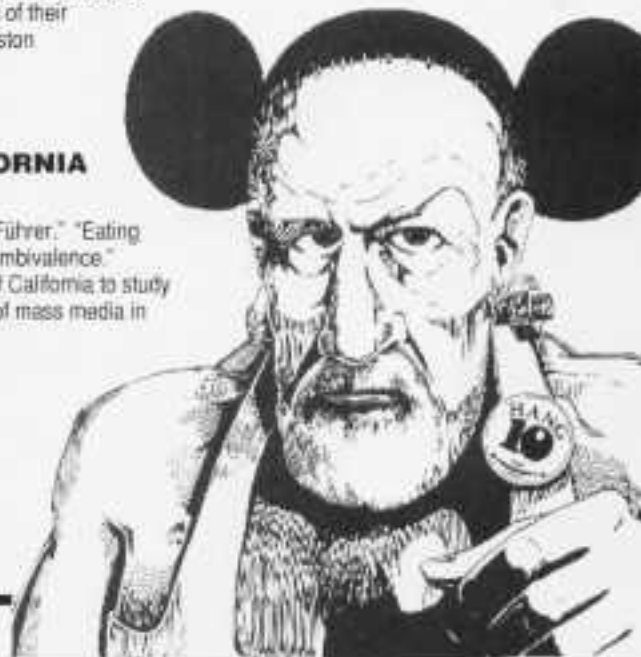
